Brief Description Of Work

Pochin Construction was appointed in October 2008 as the main contractor to carry out the construction of a new regional office for the Welsh Assembly Government at Llandudno Junction.

Built under a c£21m JCT Design and Build contract the new 9000m² office facilities will ultimately accommodate up to 650 staff.

The building design utilises many local materials with the cladding being predominately Natural Welsh Slate and Folded Copper whilst still offering state of the art performance. Specific Security and Bomb Blast requirements are being incorporated into the design.

The Building will achieve a BREEAM Excellent standard and will incorporate a Biomass Boiler, Grey Water recycling and a Water Feature Cooling System.
