

Keele IC2



Description

Pochin (Contractors) Ltd. were awarded the Design & Build contract to construct IC2 by Keele Park Developments following the successful completion and occupation of IC1, thus providing further Office and Laboratory facilities on the Keele University Campus.

The building is set on the slope above IC1 and has a central core with wings forming a gentle 'v' shape along the contours of the hill and provides accommodation over 3 levels.

Designed as a steel frame structure with a mixture of Cladding and Brickwork, it has a tiered car park at the rear and an open aspect over the campus below.

Alongside the construction of this Innovation centre, Pochin carried out extensive new access road developments through the campus to facilitate for this and other future developments.
